Example of Proper Bulk Set-Out



To receive bulk pick-up, customers must schedule bulk service with the RAD office by calling 480-983-9101.

If you have called to schedule bulk collection, you will need to make sure all materials are set out properly and placed curbside prior to 6 a.m. on the day of collection. Materials will be collected by 6 p.m. on the assigned day. The allowed area for bulk is 6 cubic yards.

Example of Improper Bulk Set-Out



DOs	DON'Ts
DO - Cut tree branches and wood into 4 foot lengths and bundle/tie together with twine, duct tape etc.	DO NOT - Place unbundled limbs or yard waste in a pile without being tied together.
DO - Place loose yard waste such as leaves/grass in bags.	DO NOT - Place construction materials (concrete, dirt, rock, gravel, concrete blocks, drywall) at curb. Construction debris is solid waste derived from the construction, repair, remodeling of structures and will not be collected.
DO - Place furniture, such as tables, chairs and couches at curb. No special preparation required.	DO NOT - Place oil, paint, batteries or any other hazardous materials out for collection. They will not be accepted.
DO - Place century plants, cactus and other similar plants in boxes.	DO NOT - Items not accepted in bulk collection include: <i>Carpet, Tires, Refrigerators, Freezers, Horse Manure, Hazardous Materials, Construction Materials.</i>

Materials accepted in bulk collection include:

- ✓ **Furniture and Large Appliances**
(excluding refrigerators/freezers)
- ✓ **Household Garbage and Cardboard** *(including items that don't easily fit into the trash can)*
- ✓ **Yard Debris (remember the three B's: Bagged, Bundled or Boxed)**
 - Grass, yard clippings must be bagged or boxed; not to exceed 50 pounds per bag/box
 - Tree limbs no longer than 4 foot in length and are to be bundled and tied with twine, string, duct tape or similar so one person can handle. Logs and limbs not more than 12 inches in diameter are acceptable.
 - Century plants, all cacti and similar plants that are hazardous to our collection employees should be boxed to avoid injury.

BULK PICK-UP WAS NOT PERFORMED TODAY DUE TO:

- Tree branches/limbs not properly bundled and tied
- Yard debris not cut down to 4ft and/or larger than 12 inches in diameter
- Construction debris – not acceptable
- Other unacceptable material _____
